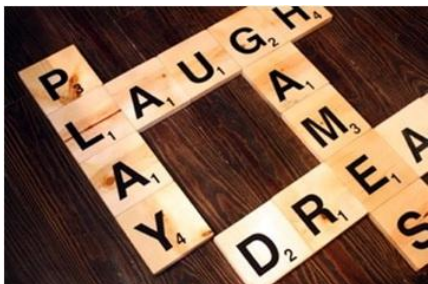
January Tea at the Library
