

Fall Tech Help at the Library

SOUTHWEST HARBOR – During the fall, the Southwest Harbor Public Library offers free tech help three days a week. Please note, hardware and maintenance issues on private computers are beyond the scope of this assistance.

Monday afternoons, 2:00 – 4:00 and Saturday mornings, 9:30 – 12:30 help is offered for basic computer tasks such as setting up an email account, transferring photos, completing online forms, attaching photos to emails, scanning documents, creating and using documents in Word, Excel, Access, Google Drive, etc. Laptop users are encouraged to bring their own computer. Appointments are recommended for a one-on-one half hour session, or drop in with the chance that you may have to wait until our volunteer is available.

Thursday afternoons, 1:30 – 2:00, Individual Apple tech help is offered for Apple laptops and devices, and downloadable ebooks, audiobooks and music. Please call to make an appointment for this one-on-one half hour session.

Thursday afternoons, 2:00 – 3:00, Shared Apple Tech help is offered for multiple patrons to get help at the same time with downloadable ebooks, audiobooks, music, and Apple devices. Drop-ins are welcome.
